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| TIMING OF THE PRESCRIPTION | |
| Q | ACS is a new preschool provider. Would we be an EnterClaims or Portal client? |
| A | CLAIMS/EnterClaims is a proprietary software that needs to be purchased from McGuinness. If your agency does not have a contract with McGuinness for the CLAIMS/EnterClaims software, you will be using the Portal. |
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| Q | Where is the Implementation Guide? |
| A | The Guide was attached to the email that providers received from the county announcing that McGuinness would be their Medicaid Contractor. If you need a copy of the Implementation Guide, please email Medicaid@CPSEPortal.com . Someone from the Medicaid Team will forward you a copy. |
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| Q | Will Admin staff be able to perform tasks like entering the SLP Digital referral? |
| A | No. Only SLPs can create digital orders. Each therapist has their own Portal Profile, Password and Digital PIN #, which should not be shared with anyone. |
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| Q | Can Admin staff enter all of the information for the digital referral – but not sign the referral? |
| A | Digital referrals are auto-filled with information already in the Portal. The only information that the SLP will enter on the digital recommendation is the ICD Code and the SLP's digital PIN #. |
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| Q | If the Agency uses EnterClaims, will the Pre-License and Supervision Plans be done in the Portal? |
| A | Yes. Currently there is no mechanism in EnterClaims for the Supervision Process. |
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
