Consistent with the New York State (NYS) Compliance Agreement with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), NYS is providing continuing School Supportive Health Services Program (SSHSP) training for relevant employees. SSHSP WebEx fall training sessions have been scheduled during the months of November and December 2017.

These sessions will be limited to the annual SSHSP cost reporting and desk review aspects of the certified public expenditure (CPE) component of the SSHSP. Because the random moment time study (RMTS) has been suspended for the 2017-18 school year, there is no need for an RMTS training this fall. This CPE process overview will be presented by representatives from the Department of Health's contractor, public Consulting Group, Inc.

The following relevant employees are invited to attend one 90-minute training session: School district/county employees responsible for submission or development of cost reports; RMTS coordinators; and school district/county compliance officers (if applicable). Participation in a WebEx session is not mandatory, but is strongly encouraged for any staff new to the CPE process, or those with any cost reporting or RMTS questions. These Fall 2017 CPE trainings are being held as cost reporting is under way for the 2016-17 school year.

Registration is required. Participants may register at any time prior to the start of a session by clicking on the applicable Register Here link in the following NYSSHSP WebEx Training Schedule. CPE Cost Report Training

IEP Ratio Methodology and Reporting Updates

- ► IEP Ratio denominator is "total number of students in the LEA with a direct medical service, as outlined in their IEP"
- Previously, this was
 - Calculated for you by BOCES
 - Based on a BEDS Day snapshot of your data
- Going forward
 - Must be supplied by you
 - Based on full school year of data





Students in the LEA with a Direct Medical Service as outlined in their IEP

- ► The SED Medicaid Website (http://www.oms.nysed.gov/medicaid/) lists the Direct Medical Service as OT, PT, ST, Psychological Counseling, Skilled Nursing, Psychological Evaluation, Medical Evaluation, Medical Specialist Evaluation, Audiological Evaluation
- Children with a Fee For Service Related Services that is a direct medical service (OT, PT, ST, etc.), are identified based on the existence of the related service enrollment
- For children in a center based tuition program we can only identify them if you indicate in the Preschool system that child has a direct medical service







Defining Direct Medical Service in Preschool

Need to setup Preschool

- Before we can actually run the new reports, we need some minor setup in Preschool
- We need you to tie the related service types and evaluation types, to which services should be reported on the cost report.
- There is a new screen under the Maintenance menu for Service Types

Populate "SSHSP Cost Report" column

- ► There are two tabs, Service & Eval. Both have a SSHSP Cost Report Column
- Text must match PCG list exactly (spelling, spaces, capitalization)
- Only services with a value in the SSHSP cost report column will be included
- Allowable services from PCG list


Indicating Direct Medical Service for Tuition Children


- Three options
 - 1. Enter the services from the IEP using the "RS in CB" screen
 - 2. Mark the tuition enrollment as having a Medicaid eligible service
 - 3. Make the very risky assumption that all center based children have a medical eligible service on their IEP
- We recommend using option 1, enter the services from the IEP
- Option 2 is a reasonable solution when used accurately
- We do not recommend option 3





Entering RS in CB services (aka CBRS)










How to tell if your County enters RS in CB

- If you are unsure of whether your county enters CBRS
 - Run the Enrollment Detail Listing Report (from top menu Reports->Enrollment Reports->Enrollment Detail Listing)
 - Run the report for just CB/RS service types
 - ▶ If there are only rows for Medicaid Children (CIN column), you probably only enter for Medicaid claiming which is insufficient








Marking the tuition enrollment as having a Medicaid eligible service


- In lieu of entering the related services in a tuition program from the IEP, you can also just indicate that the child has them
- On County Center Based enrollment screen, click the check box "Has Medicaid Medical Service on IEP"
- This is automatically updated when you enter RS in CB








Batch updates of "Has Medicaid Medical Service on IEP"






- Retrieve fills the grid
- <u>Excel</u> exports grid to Excel
- You can update the 1st column by clicking in the grid
- Update from RS in CB, will check the box for every CB enrollment that has corresponding CBRS that are Medicaid eligible
- Mark All will check the box for every row
- Un-Mark All will clear the box for every row





Transportation

- If you plan on claiming Transportation for PSSHSP reimbursement, preschool can help collect the data needed for the report.
- To do this, on the grey transportation enrollment screen, use the radio buttons on the top to note the MA billable status







Transportation

Medicaid One-Way Trip Ratio:

- A Medicaid one-way trip is defined as a trip in which a Medicaid enrolled student who has specialized transportation services in their IEP and received another Medicaid-covered service provided by the school district or county on the day of the trip. The numerator will be completed by PCG based on paid claims data
- If you entered trip information into preschool, the "Medicaid Cost Report" data will give you the data needed to complete the transportation information

Transportation

Specialized Transportation:

- The Specialized Transportation Ratio is used to break out specialized transportation costs from general transportation costs.
- If you used the "Medicaid Status" buttons on the Transportation enrollments, Preschool can report this data


Total Number of ALL Students Receiving Transportation Services (Specialized or Non Specialized)






Medicaid Cost Report





- Enter your date range
- Choose the appropriate method for determining which tuition enrollments have a Direct Medical Service on their IEP. This method is used for both the IEP ratio as well as determining what tuition costs should be reported








- Annual Contractor Costs
 - List that can be exported to CSV and uploaded to PCG reporting site
 - All individuals whose costs are captured in this section must be included on the Supplemental Form for Contracted Practitioners - this includes BOCES
 - Contract costs should only be reported for students with an IEP for a related service
 - Reminder: Contract Costs with other school districts or counties must be reported in Intergovernmental Contract Cost
 - Reminder: BOCES must be included in this section. The costs by discipline will need to be provided by them. These costs must be entered by hand on the Contractor Cost Schedule


Total Number of Medicaid Eligible IEP Students with a Direct Medical Service in their IEP



Total Number of ALL IEP Students with a Direct Medical Service in their IEP












- Transportation Other Costs
 - ► This is the Total Transportation costs for ANY child marked "Special Transportation"








Annual Tuition costs

- Need to be directly entered into PCG site- they do not accept the CSV upload for Tuition as they do for Contract Costs
- Tuition cost should ONLY be reported for costs associated with a student who had an IEP for a related service
- Reminder- Public School tuition should NOT be reported in Annual Tuition Cost. This should be reported in Intergovernmental Tuition
- Reminder- Omit BOCES- the cost should be broken out by related service and reported in the Annual Contract Cost section












- ► IEP Ratio listing
 - Prior years had to submit this thru CNYRIC
 - No new directions on when/if this is to be submitted this year
 - You can export to Excel the names of the children that comprise the IEP Ratio Denominator if you want to save this information












Warnings if not using CBRS

- ▶ If you select "Use RS Included in CB Entries to determine..." and the system notices that less than 50% of your CB tuition enrollments have corresponding CBRS,
 - You will be prompted with a warning
 - You will need to type "OK" to continue



- Then the numbers will have disclaimers indicating possible unreliability of the IEP Ratio and Tuition costs








Additional Reports

- 2 Reports:
 - ► Total Service Encounters
 - Supplemental Form (list of providers with NPI)
- ► For Counties that used CPSE Portal for all providers, all services, for the entire period of the cost report, there are 2 reports you can run to complete these
- These reports are found on the Portal under Medicaid Service Bureau, Medicaid Cost Report
- All other Counties must get this information directly from their agencies/providers



Additional Reports-Encounters

- An encounter is defined as a documented face-to-face direct medical service visit that was provided pursuant to the recommendations of a students IEP by a qualified provider
- Need both fee for service related service sessions plus tuition based services to be counted
- Payments for non-treatment sessions should not be reported (CPSE meetings, etc.)
- Sessions that are not the full duration specified in the IEP should not be counted. If IEP says 2x45, and one day the session was only 40 minutes, that should not be counted


Additional Reports- Supplemental Form-List of Contracted Providers

- LEAs should only report Annual Contract Cost and Intergovernmental Contract Cost for students with an IEP for the health related service and are provided by Medicaid approved and qualified practitioner.
- Once the LEA has completed the cost report, the LEA should complete the Supplemental Form. The form should include the first name, last name, full professional job title, and NPI number for all practitioners associated with cost reported on the cost report.
- If the practitioner who provided the service works UDO a supervisor, then the LEA should report the supervisor's information in the "Supervisors Information" field of the form.
- If any of the above information is missing, the form will be considered incomplete.

BOCES - Tuition

- ▶ BOCES tuition programs should not be reported as tuition costs
- Instead, the costs for the direct medical services should be broken out of the tuition and reported as contractor costs
- How are the service costs broken out of the tuition? According to PCG...

B) A follow up for the BOCES question.

Where should BOCES tuition fees be reported?
BOCES tuition should NOT be reported, just service cost

The payments to BOCES are single payment for both Tuition and services. For some Counties, the vast majority of the medical service costs are embedded in tuition payments to BOCES.

What guidance does PCG have for determining those medical services costs?

Some possibilities are could be:

Could BOCES use the County fee for service rate for that service and then approximate it by multiplying the corresponding fee-for-service rate times the # of services provided?

BOCES should be able to break out the health related expense at the LEA's request.

- It has been reported in your trainings/presentations, that PCG calculates a Health Related Tuition Percentage for each provider based on their CFR. Can PCG provide that to BOCES so that BOCES can apply that factor to approximate a cost?
- We do not get a HRTP for BOCES because BOCES is not approved as a State Approved School for the purposes of this cost report.

CPE Cost Report Training by PCG

- Important Reminders:
- In order to report an allowed medical service cost, the service must be provided by a Medicaid qualified practitioner.
- The service must be included in the individual's IEP.
- The report must use Accrual Based Accounting.





Medicaid in Education Alert

Issue #17-05

The Department of Health is implementing internal system updates to accommodate changes to physical and occupational therapy evaluation and reevaluation billing codes. CPT codes 97001-97004 are replaced with 97161-97168 for dates of service on and after January 1, 2018. See Table 1 in this alert for the new CPT and rate codes for SSHSP billing.

As stated in Medicaid Alert #16-08, changes to the SSHSP CPT code list were necessary to comply with physical and occupational therapy evaluation and reevaluation CPT code changes made in January 2017 by the American Medical Association (AMA). The new evaluation codes reflect 3 levels of patient presentation: low-complexity, moderate- complexity, and high-complexity. However, there will be no change in the reimbursement rates for physical and occupational therapy evaluations and re-evaluations. Service providers should refer to their professional associations (e.g., The American Occupational Therapy Association, Inc. and the American Physical Therapy Association) for guidance on the use of the new codes.

Prior to January 1, 2018 each enrolled SSHSP billing provider should receive correspondence from CSRA on behalf of the NYS Department of Health (DOH) indicating that the new billing codes have been added to their Medicaid enrollment file. The new codes must be used when billing SSHSP Medicaid for evaluations and re-evaluations conducted on and after January 1, 2018........
